### **SUMMARY OF POSITION:**

Case Managers in the Life Builders program provide integrated Biblical counseling to the residents on their caseload. Through counseling and case management, residents are encouraged to develop a healthy addiction-free lifestyle by developing a relationship with Jesus Christ. Case Managers may also teach classes which come from a strong biblical foundation. Case Managers assist in the daily operations of the program to ensure an atmosphere that promotes godly living, safety and support.

### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### Interactions with Mission Residents

- Counsel residents as assigned by the Program Manager on a weekly basis to provide integrated, Biblically based counseling.
- Perform new resident related responsibilities as assigned, including:
  - Screen referral applications
  - Conduct intake interviews
  - Provide orientation information to new residents
- Teach classes as assigned:
  - Classes are designed to encourage spiritual growth and foster a relationship with God that teaches the residents how to rely on God and be who He wants them to be.
  - Classes are taught from and rely on the authority of the Scriptures.
  - Examples of classes taught include: Anger Management, Financial Management, Life Skills, relapse prevention, and Christian living.
- Perform other current resident related responsibilities as assigned, including:
  - Collect samples for urinalysis, and administer breathalyzer tests
  - Carry out roll call
  - Perform medicine call duties
  - Schedule internal and external meetings and appointments
- Participate in the discipline process for residents who violate the rules, up to and including dismissal from the program.
- Maintain current and complete case notes and records for each resident.
- Encourage eligible residents to apply to the one-year Transformers Program.

#### General

- Meet with other WSRM staff to discuss the progress of the resident and program needs.
- Network with related service providers within the community to access needed services for residents.
- Attend staff meetings.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

### **EDUCATION/EXPERIENCE:**

- Bachelor's degree required in Biblical studies, Biblical counseling, or related field.
- Minimum 3-year ministry experience required; 3 5+ years ministry experience preferred.
- Minimum one-year biblical counseling experience preferred.
- Experience working directly with individuals who have had homeless, mental illness, and/or addiction related issues preferred.

- Christian with a ministry mindset, utilizing the skills, training and experience God has provided.
- Mature Christian, able and willing to model servant-leadership.
- Active member of the body of Christ; strong familiarity with the Bible.
- Able to work with people in varied circumstances related to homelessness, including addiction and mental illness. Ability to treat individuals with dignity and respect in all situations.
- Good communication skills including written, verbal and instructional.
- Strong interpersonal skills, ability to listen and guide/counsel according to Biblical principles and individual resident needs.
- Working knowledge of recovery, addiction, and mental illness.
- Thorough, systematic, and organized concerning security and protocol.
- Good assessment skills, able to collaborate and resolve resident issues.
- Good organization skills with regard to people, things, and information, including excellent time management skills.
- Computer literate proficient in Microsoft Word, able to use a database and the internet.
- Willing to be CPR certified.
- Valid North Carolina driver's license; driving record acceptable to WSRM insurance carrier.
