# “I’ve been restored!”

Tim had a good job, a happy marriage and a beautiful son. “I was blessed with a wonderful life,” he says.

Then his wife was diagnosed with muscular dystrophy and, for 15 years, Tim was her devoted caregiver, looking out for her every need. But it took a heavy toll. “I started drinking in the evenings and it progressed to where I was planning my days around drinking.”

Finally, his wife left, moving in with their son and leaving Tim overcome with guilt. His life spiraled out of control, eventually landing him in jail. And, there, he fell to his knees and cried out to God. “I asked Him for forgiveness and direction.”

When he was released, Tim had nowhere to go and, while staying at a shelter, the Lord answered his jailhouse prayer through Tim’s son. “He encouraged me to come to the Rescue Mission.”


Tim entered our Life Builders Program, where Bible studies and chapel services strengthened his faith. “I was saved 35 years ago and the Rescue Mission brought me back to the Lord.”

Christian counseling and fellowship helped Tim process his feelings of guilt, as well. “It’s been difficult for me to forgive myself, but with the help of my case manager, teachers and peers, I’m healing.”

After completing Life Builders, Tim entered our Transformers Program, where he continued to grow spiritually and emotionally, while developing the tools and skills for healthy, self-reliant living. His son is overjoyed with his transformation. “We speak frequently and he’s very encouraged about the future.”

Now a graduate of Transformers, Tim earned his Peer Support Certification and is currently serving as the Evening Supervisor at the Rescue Mission. He is being used to encourage others to hope in God, stay in His Word and wait for the good plans God has for them.

**Tim is thankful for the kindness and compassion of loving neighbors like you – and how you have given him peace and hope for the future.** “When I came to the Rescue Mission, my life began to unfold the way God intended. I’ve been restored.”
