

When Ben was a boy, he had a close relationship with the Lord, praying every day and trying to do God's will. But, when he was 12, his grandmother died, leaving him heartbroken and fearful of death, so he ran from the Lord and began numbing his pain with drugs. "I stopped praying and lost my connection with God."

Over the years, Ben's addiction escalated, damaging his family relationships and affecting his mental health. "I started hearing voices and having paranoid delusions and I became very reclusive."

Then he became an uncle and his desire to be a good role model for his niece and nephew drove him to change his life. "I had a come-to-God moment and He led me to the Rescue Mission."

Ben entered our Life Builders Program, where Bible studies, chapel services and Christian counseling have helped him draw close to the Lord once again. "Now, I talk to God often and I feel His presence," Ben says. "Prayer and the Word are my weapons to battle addiction."

Through his faith and sobriety, Ben has found healing for his mind and his relationships. "God has restored my mental health. It's a true testament to His power and grace," Ben says. "And my family is really proud of me. My dad even started going to church because he saw what God had done in my life."

Ben graduated from the program and earned a certificate in Radio Broadcasting and Production, with plans to, one day, start a Christian radio station. He also earned a Peer Support Specialist certification and is now on our live-in staff, monitoring our shelter in the evenings and sharing his testimony of transformation at every turn.

Ben's heart is overflowing with gratitude this Thanksgiving because YOUR loving support gave him the confidence and support to rebuild his life. "When I got here, God shined His light on me and I was reborn."
