Michael was raised by a single mother, and although she did the best she could, he needed and longed for a male role model. "My father wasn't in my life at all and I didn't really know what it meant to be a man."

When he became a father, Michael was overjoyed that his own son would grow up in a two-parent home. But before long, he and his girlfriend separated. "It filled me with grief, shame and guilt," he says. "Instead of pursuing Christ Jesus for comfort, I chose to numb my pain with drugs and alcohol."

Within a few years, Michael's beloved mother died unexpectedly, sending his addiction and his life spiraling out of control. "I lost my job, my vehicle and my home, and I was growing distant from my child. I felt like there was no way out."

He was thinking of taking his own life when he had a moment of clarity. He realized that it was only by God's grace and mercy that he'd survived the years of addiction, so perhaps God had a purpose for his life. "I said, 'I surrender, Lord!"

Then he came to the Rescue Mission, where God's Word, chapel services and Christian counseling transformed him. "The staff taught me, guided me, loved me and challenged me. Now, my relationship with Christ is closer than ever."

Today, Michael is a godly role model for his son, shares messages in our chapel services and leads Bible studies for other program men. He also serves on our Thrift Store staff and has begun to pursue a degree in Biblical studies at Carolina University. "God has called me to ministry," he says. "Now, I have a purpose."
