When Robert was a little boy, he gave no thought to what he wanted to be when he grew up. For him, dreaming was pointless. "My grandmother raised me and the whole time I was growing up she told me I was no good, that I'd never amount to anything," he says. "It stuck with me."

His only plan was to drift, so after his high school graduation ceremony, he went directly to the bus station, still wearing his robe, and hopped a Greyhound headed west. "I wound up in San Francisco, where I was introduced to drugs and alcohol," he says. "I became addicted and homeless and lived under a bridge for 15 years, isolated from everybody."

Then, one night, Robert sensed God reaching out to him in the darkness. "I surrendered. **I got down on my knees and prayed, 'God, please help me. I don't want to live this way anymore'** and I felt Him say, 'You have to take the first step.""

That's when Robert made his way east and God led him to our Transformers Program. Since then, his faith has grown stronger day-by-day through Bible studies, devotions and chapel services. "I talk with God every morning and night," Robert says. "We're very connected."

Through counseling and life skills classes, he's also found healing for his emotional wounds. **His** grandmother's words no longer control his life. He knows that he's valuable and has purpose. "I used to be angry, but I'm happy now."

When Robert completes the program, he'll be ready to transition to productive, independent living. "They'll help me get a job, a place to live, furniture, whatever I need to start over again," he says. "Then I'm going to shelters and churches to share my testimony of what God has done."

Robert is thankful for the way you have answered God's calling to love your neighbor as yourself – and have helped him learn how to love himself. "I've been given a second chance at life." I FEEL LIKE A WHOLE NEW PERSON.
