# "The Rescue Mission cradled our hurting son in God's love."

**R** odney grew up in a loving, Christian home, but he never learned about the dangers of addiction. "We were really naïve about drugs," his mother, Kathy, says.

After he left home, Rodney fell in with a rough crowd, and when they started partying, he joined in. "I was hanging out with the wrong people at the wrong time," he says.

Over the years, Rodney's addiction escalated, but he kept it hidden from his parents. "He'd call to chat and gave us no indication that he was into drugs," Kathy says.

Eventually, Rodney wound up living in his car. For six months, he struggled to get by, and finally, he moved home. That's when his parents realized

something was terribly wrong. They tried

to help their son, but to no avail. "We gave up hope," his father, Jimmy, says.

But during his years away from home, Rodney had a child, and one day, the boy called and gave his father an ultimatum. "He said that if I didn't change, he wouldn't have anything to do with me anymore," Rodney says.

It was the catalyst Rodney needed to change his life. He entered our Life Builders Program, and through devotions, chapel services, counseling and life skills classes, he surrendered his life to the Lord and learned to live out his faith. "I got saved and they gave me a firm foundation to stand on."

Rodney graduated and is now living with his parents and his son, working and saving money for a home. He's planted in a church, and in his free time, he volunteers at the Rescue Mission, sharing his testimony with other hurting men. "The change in Rodney is remarkable," Jimmy says. "We're so proud."

"It's the best feeling in the world to have my parents feel like that about me again," Rodney adds.
