# Michael's Story

Before I came to the Winston-Salem Rescue Mission my life was filled with drug use. I tried many times to stop using, but couldn't. I was in and out of jails, institutions and homeless shelters. As a result of my addiction I lost jobs, a great wife and my relationship with my son and daughter. When I could no longer hold down a job or a place to reside, I knew I needed help.

After coming here I completed the 90-Day Life Builder's Program and the 1-Year Transformers Program. I am employed now, working on my GED and I am developing a support system including regular AA/NA meetings, home group and attending worship services at Winston-Salem First.

God has restored my relationship with my ex-wife and daughter and I have role models in my life today that have years of recovery.
